Rick Allen was appointed as the National Men's Ministry and Light for the Lost Director in January 2013. Along with this position, he serves as a national facilitator of the Church Transformation Initiative and an AG Trust Development Team member.

In his role as National LFTL Director, Rick travels throughout the world working with missionaries and ministry partners to ensure they are fully equipped with the evangelism resources necessary to spread the gospel. He also speaks nationwide at various events to accomplish the vision of LFTL – One Message, Many Languages.

Prior to his appointment, Rick has served in numerous positions including: U.S. Missionary with emphasis on church revitalization and mission fundraising from 2001 to 2014, assisting OneHope with the Book of Hope U.S.A. from 2001 to 2003, mentoring pastors as the Church Enrichment Director in the Arkansas District from 2003 to 2006. In 2006, Rick's missionary assignment brought him to the National Office as the overseer for the Reach America Coalition for U.S. Missions and National Facilitator for Church Transformation Initiative in the Acts II process.

Prior to his time as a U.S. appointed missionary, Rick held senior pastorates at churches in Arkansas and Tennessee as well as youth pastorates in Texas, Arkansas, and Tennessee. He also served on the National Child Services Agency for the United States Senate.
