



## Day 11: COURAGE TO BE A MAN OF GOD

### Scripture Reading:

I Chronicles 28:20 (ESV)

Psalms 27:1 (ESV)

Psalms 56:3-4 (ESV)

### Observation:

I was a young Christian man at the time. I was unsure what this “born again” thing was all about, but I knew that God had called me. What I did not know was that He wanted all of me, not just the parts that were comfortable. So, as I stood in the grocery store with my friend, he asked me to pray for him.
