Scripture Readings:

Hebrews 10:36 (ESV)

Hebrews 12:7 (ESV)

Observation:

A statement I read from a pastor: “Bad decisions become bad directions!” Many times in life, we will need to endure through a bad decision on our part. While working at a customer’s home, I made a bad decision that lead to a rather long day where I needed to endure through it.
