## Day 5: Endure Through Bad Financial Decisions

### Scripture Readings:

Hebrews 10:36 (ESV)

1 Timothy 6:10 (ESV)

### Observation:

I remember receiving my first real paycheck. I immediately cashed it and began to spend every last cent on foolish things. When it came time to pay some bills that were due at the end of the month, I had nothing left! My foolish financial choices left me having to endure the rest of the month without any money.

Paul shares in 1 Timothy 6:10 that “the love of money is a root of all kinds of evils.” God has called you to be good stewards of your finances but sometimes you can make bad decisions that leave you having to endure the mess you made. Remember, money is not the root of evil, but the love of it is. When money becomes your craving, you can lose sight of what is truly important!
